



COVID-19 PROCEDURES and PROTOCOLS

- If you are not feeling well, please stay home
- If you have been exposed to someone who is not feeling well, or who has tested positive for COVID-19, please stay home
- A mask must always be worn-- while in the Bridgewater Sports Arena and Rock Ice. Masks are not required while on the ice. Please ensure skaters and visitors arrive to the facility with a mask
- Daily Health Declaration Form must be completed each time any skater or visitor will be arriving to the facilities (link below)
- All skaters and visitors must complete the COVID-19 waiver one time (link below)
- All skaters and visitors must complete the Social Responsibility Waiver one time (link below)
- All skaters and visitors must agree to a health screening upon arrival
- **Skaters are to arrive no more than 15 minutes before their scheduled start time and must exit the facility within 15 minutes of the end of their session.**
- All showers will be closed
- Locker Rooms are closed
- All skaters must be dressed in full equipment while on the ice

The Latest Executive order from Governor Murphy speaks to capacity and necessity for non-contact/contact games and practices. The AAHA has asked we adjust our previous protocols.

- a. One parent will be allowed for Mites, Learn to Skate and Learn to Play. No other spectators are allowed.**
 - b. Locker Rooms are to be closed- please come completely dressed and bring in skates and sticks only. We are working on an outdoor solution for easier changing and distancing.**
 - c. One parent per team will be allowed to come in for games, to live stream for the parents. We are working on a solution for live broadcasts.**
 - d. Games for players Squirt and older, coaches, refs, scorekeeper, penalty box assistant, and one parent to live stream/and or game day operators required for Junior games.**
- Please comply with any requests from the rink staff and be kind- we are all under a lot of stress and doing our best
 - All rink water fountains, vending machines, and concessions have been removed. Please bring your own water bottle to the rink
 - Walk-in registrations will not be allowed. All registrations are to be done ahead of time, online.

 - The main telephone line to the Bridgewater Sports Arena will not be utilized as we work to keep our staff with limited contact to surfaces.
